Stage Makeup is an invaluable tool for the actor and performer. Learn techniques for makeup application for various characters including corrective makeup, aging, bruises and cuts, historical makeup, fantasy makeup, and more! Please note that students will be required to purchase their own makeup kit (approx. \$20) and a few extra supplies. A small amount of (fun!) homework will also be required.
